Indian Love Call by Judy Kay-Wolff

Life isn't always a bowl of cherries and we are prone to forget the joys of life and dwell more profoundly on our losses. In the Jewish tradition, mourning the passing of a loved one is known as "Sitting Shiva" — a recognized observance of bereavement which continues for seven days.
