Grand National Teams

Play in the Grand National Teams (GNT) and your team could win a National Championship without ever leaving Las Vegas! More experienced players already know this is a great event. Flight C players: Do not miss this event!! Put together a team or let us help you find a team because YOU WILL LOVE THE GNTs! This is a great bridge event.

Flights

Put together a team of 4-6 players in one of the following flights:

Championship (unlimited masterpoints)

Flight A (up to 5,000 MPs as of 9/1/07)

Flight B (up to 2,000 MPs as of 9/1/07)

Flight C (Non-Life Masters & up to 500 MPs as of 9/1/07)

Each member of the team must have less than the masterpoint limit.

Club Qualifying Games

First, qualify at the club level. Play in a qualifying game at any Las Vegas bridge club now through February 15, 2008. The following GNT Qualifying games are scheduled:

A Bridge Connection: Sun., Oct. 27, 2007 and Sun., Jan. 27, 2008

Henderson Bridge Club: Sat., Dec. 1, 2007

Check with the club owners for other GNT qualifying games. The unit will schedule additional qualifying games if needed. Fifty percent of all teams entered will qualify for the next level of competition, the district finals.

District Finals

Second, you must win at the district level. Play in the District 17 GNT Finals February 29 - March 2, 2008 (Flights B & C play February 29-March 1) at the Las Vegas Regional. Winners in each flight advance to the National Championship.

National Finals

Your team could be the one to win the National GNT Championship, July 16, 2008 at the Las Vegas NABC.
