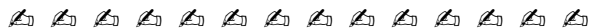

## Member Profile

Kai Larsen will celebrate his 90th birthday on Nov. 9. You may know Kai as a very good bridge player. You may not know that before he came to Las Vegas from San Francisco in 1976, Kai played football for the Stanford Indians, one of most famous college football teams of all time.

By his senior year of 1940-41, prospects were poor for the Indians (as they were then known in that less politically correct time). The school had hired a remarkable new coach, Clark Shaughnessy, possibly the most innovative coach of all time. Shaughnessy had developed a friendship with George Halas, the coach and owner of the Chicago Bears, and together they had worked out the modern T-formation. The Indians would become the first collegiate team to use the new formation.

Kai played left halfback behind Pete Kmetovic, who, like the other three members of the starting backfield, QB Frankie Albert, FB Norm Standlee, and RH Hugh Gallarneau, went on to a professional football career. Kai stresses that he didn't play very much, as the rules of the day didn't permit many substitutions and the starters played both offense and defense. Anyway, the Indians went undefeated (10-0), won the Pacific Coast Conference championship, and beat Nebraska in the 1942 Rose Bowl.

Shortly after Kai's graduation, the United States entered World War II, and Kai found himself in the Navy. One day, unable to find a poker game, Kai was introduced to bridge, which was unfortunate for the other three players. Kai never played much tournament bridge, favoring rubber bridge, but he did win a prestigious money bridge tournament in Las Vegas in 1960 (one of the first in the U. S.) with partner Ron Von Der Porten and teammates Marshall Miles and Eddie Kantar.

Kai's son is world champion Kyle Larsen, now 58. Kai also has a daughter three years younger than Kyle.

When you wish Kai a happy birthday on or about Nov. 9, you will be one, not six, degrees from football (and bridge) history.
